Langkawi & the Buntangs

Langkawi, on the northwest coast of Malaysia, is an internationally served resort destination set against the backdrop of a beautiful mountainous rainforest. With 3 marinas, and 99 islands in the surrounding area, including the beautiful Butang group, Langkawi is an established yachting haven. Cruises can also venture south to the island of Penang.

Phuket & Phan Nga Bay

Dotted with over 100 islands, the area is notable for its breathtaking geography with steep karst mountains rising vertically from sea, hidden turquoise lagoons and idyllic beaches. Phang Nga Bay also has the legendary islands and beaches of Phi-Phi and Krabi, with trendy lounge bars, fire dancers. Northwest of Phuket lie the Similan and Surin Islands which have a deserved reputation for offering the best diving in Thailand. Whale sharks, Manta rays and Leopard sharks are common sightings. Not just a divers paradise, above water is a tropical paradise.

Andaman & Nicobar

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands, part of the Union Territory of India, are isolated, pristine, with deserted white sand beaches and virgin jungles. Located 400 miles west of Phuket, there are over 500 islands extending north to south, with India's only active volcano. Some islands are uninhabited, others rich in aboriginal culture, such as the out-of-bounds North Sentinel, where indigenous inhabitants are among the last people to remain virtually untouched by modern civilization. The Andamans are also a diver's paradise characterised by stunning underwater visibility.





North Borneo – Myanmar (Burma)

The Mergui Archipelago of Burma is one of the last remaining untouched paradises on earth. An archipelago of 800 virtually uninhabited islands, Mergui is characterised by dense mountainous rainforests, white silica sand beaches and perfect natural bays providing ideal shelter for visiting yachts. Diving and snorkeling is superb, with great variety. On the beaches macaques and monitor lizards can be seen feeding on crabs at low tide. Hornbills and sea eagles fly from the rainforest canopy, and the dense jungle is home to large fauna; tracks have been found of the rare Asian rhinoceros. A cruise in the Mergui is the ultimate in tropical paradise exploration.

Living aboard – Inclusions/Exclusions

The charter fee includes 24 hours use of the vessel, services of the skipper, chef and crew; use of water-skis, fishing equipment, kayaks, snorkeling equipment, board games, library, DVD & sound system.

The charter fee does not include expenses such as food & beverages, fuel, mooring fees, visa fees, harbour fees, park fees, taxes, flights, airport transfers, diving.

A provisioning allowance of 20% of the charter fee is payable with balance of charter fee to cover expenses. The captain will account for all expenses in the form of receipts and any remainder of expense allowance will be refunded to the client at the end of the charter. Should you spend more than the estimated expense allowance the additional will be collected throughout your cruise. Expensed include fuel, provisioning for food & beverages, mooring fees etc...
