### Glorious food

### The beaches

Mallorca is known for its stunning beaches and each stretch of coast offers countless options for you to explore or simply lounge on. From white sand to black, turquoise water to emerald, popular with tourists or completely isolated. Find a beach to suit you!

### Palma de Mallorca

### Cabrera National Park

### Drach Caves

Cuevas del Drach or 'the dragon caves', are a natural wonder not to be missed! Explore the enormous underground caves with impressive stalactite formations then take a boat trip across one of Europe's largest underground lakes, Lake Martel. At the end of the tour you are treated to a short classical music concert by musicians who take advantage of the fine acoustics of the cave.

- 12 Jul:** Race 3 to Cruise to Cala Boquer 20NM then race to Pollenca 15NM
- 13 Jul:** Leisure day  
Recommendations – Punta de l'Avancada, Cap de Formentor, Cala Murta or Cala en Gossalba
- 14 Jul:** Race 4 to Cruise to Cala Ratjada 26NM then race to Porto Cristo - 10NM
- 15 Jul:** Leisure day  
Recommendations - Caves of Drach
- 16 Jul:** Leisure day  
Recommendations - Cala D'or Cruise 11NM
- 17 Jul:** Leisure day  
Recommendations - Cala Mondrago, Cala Caragol or Porto Petro Harbour
- 18 Jul:** Race 5 Cabrera 17NM
- 19 Jul:** Cabrera National Park
- 20 Jul:** Race 6 to Cruise to Cala Pi then race to Palma 17NM - overnight at the charter base
- 21 Jul:** Check out and go your own way from here
